#### GREETINGS FROM THE PRESIDENT

Hello, All:

Our renovation project is nearly finished! The concrete has been poured and sealed, and the seats have been re-installed. We have new safety railings in front of the first row and in our new ADA row! For your safety, we also installed a new GPS filter in the heating/air-conditioning unit, which not only neutralizes odors, but it reduces airborne particles, kills pathogens, and saves energy. It is said to deactivate COVID-19 air particles by 99.4% within 30 minutes. There is new lighting in the aisles and we are in the process of purchasing new, ADA approved, assistive listening devices. All this has been done to ensure you, our patrons, of a more enjoyable theater experience. Our new seating arrangement provides more legroom and better sightlines to the stage. All in all, some very necessary changes were made possible by grants and some very generous donations. We hope you will be pleased with the results. All that's left is the installation of new carpeting and the hanging of new stage curtains. All of which will be completed after our current production of "A Midsummer Night's Dream" in June.

Thank you to all of you who donated to us through Idaho Gives. We are grateful to the State of Idaho for the grant to replace our stage curtains with new, permanently fireproofed curtains. The Jeker Foundation helped fund the new carpeting, and the majority of the construction project was funded by the Beautrow family. Barb Beautrow's daughter Lynne, explained, "When my mom passed away, I knew I wanted to do something to honor her. I remembered that she always wanted to get the seats in the auditorium spaced out. As I went through her files, I came across a letter she'd written in 2000 to Joe Posluszny (then BLT Pres) and the Board about her 'pet project,' as she called it. It's something she'd been thinking about for a while-during her own presidency or when she filled in for Skov at the Box Office in 1988, she wasn't sure when it all started--but it was always something she hoped would happen. Sadly, her passing gave me the means to help make her dream become reality."

So, there you have it. This project has kept me, and the rest of the Board, occupied during the "COVID Closure" and we hope you all will be as happy with our "facelift" as we are! Many of the shows that we were forced to cancel in Season 73 will be on our stage for Season 74, along with some new ones. We're looking forward to a great season and hope you will join us at our Picnic & Membership meeting on Monday, July 19th. It will be fun to be together again!

Congratulations to the Cast and Crew of "A Midsummer Night's Dream!" Their opening weekend shows were both SOLD OUT! Looking forward to more of the same. Break all the legs!

New to writing? Here is an email from Heidi Kray regarding help with formatting guidelines:

"Final Draft is a good software that I use, though pretty expensive. Scrivener has software that many use that serves all kinds of writing disciplines and is less expensive. I haven't used that but plan to try it soon. Others have used Celtx, less expensive still, but I'm not a big fan. Many still use Word and some use Google Drive, and create templates themselves, though I find that more time consuming.

The Board met and elected **Darin Vickery** to serve as **President**, and **Patti Finley** to serve as **Business Manager**.

The Membership voted to approve the By-Laws Amendments as presented, most notable: (Note: the below are not word-for-word copies of the amendments. They present the basic intent of the change)

- Two classes of membership: Voting and Supporting
- Voting members must: complete membership application, indicating a desire to actively participate in the work of the theater, and pay the appropriate dues; complete 2 sessions of work for the theater (participate in set build. Attend a membership meeting, serve as an usher, participate in a show as an actor, or director, or member of the creative team; OR serve on a committee for a special project.
- Supporting members are not eligible to vote or hold office.
- Supporting members may become a Lifetime Member: a Lifetime Member must complete two work sessions to be eligible; Presidents become Lifetime Members at the end of their first term and also need to complete the work session requirements to vote.
- Elections: only **Voting** members are eligible to vote.
- The **Business Manager** shall be the treasurer and have general supervision of the Box Office staff, a publicity chairman, and an accountant.
- **♦ Term Limits:**
- 1) **Board Members** are limited to two (2) consecutive terms (4 Years) at a time; They may be re-elected to the Board after a minimum wait period of one (1) year.
- 2) **The President** shall be limited to four (4) consecutive terms at a time (4 Years) They shall again become eligible for President after a minimum wait period of one(1) year.
- 3) **Business Manager** shall be limited to five (5) consecutive terms (5 years) at a time. They shall again become eligible for Business Manager after a minimum wait period of one (1) year.
