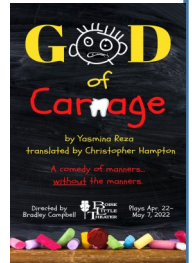

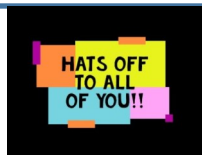
UPCOMING AUDITIONS:

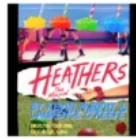
