When Boise Little Theater's past historian, Polly Price, passed away, her family did what you might expect with the bags/file folders of newspaper clippings about Boise Little Theater she had at her home: they donated them to BLT. BLT accepted them gratefully and placed them in a safe place for later review. When Helen Smith passed away, the same thing happened. When Marjorie Fairchild passed away, another collection of BLT memorabilia was added to the growing collection. When Ansgar Johnson closed his photo studio, he added the negatives and photos of BLT shows, etc. to the collection. When Kay Doty passed away, boxes of memorabilia was added. When Bethel Marshall passed away 20 more scrapbooks were added to the collection.



I think you might begin to see that this collection was really in need of some TLC. So, the intrepid team of Connie Behee and Joanna Marshall finally dived in this last year. Fortunately, I had asked Mom (Bethel Marshall) to look through the box of 8x10 black and white pictures and she had written on the back of the photos, the name of play and the identity of as many people in the pictures as she could.
