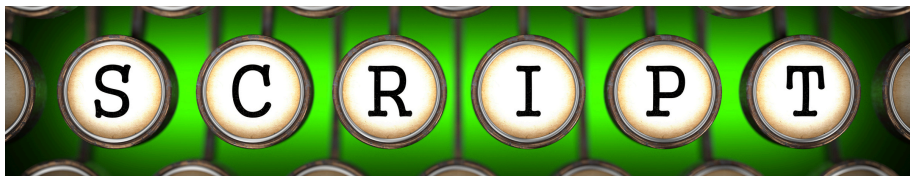


LIFETIME MEMBERS
