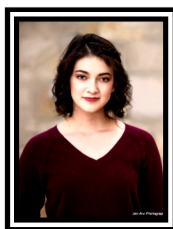
SCHOLARSHIPS

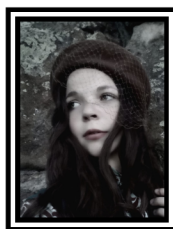

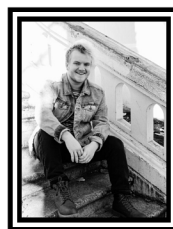
