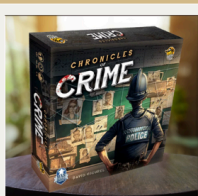

Tom Wilkinson - Stage Manager

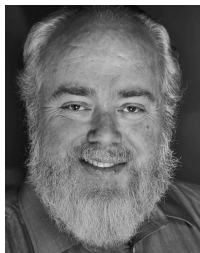

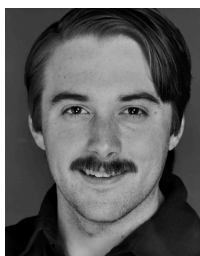


Kevin Nissen - Sherlock
